



2008 Fall Scouting Days Program Frequently Asked Questions

What groups are invited to participate?

The Fall Scouting Adventure is open to all Scouts and Explorers, their friends and families.

Do we need to make reservations?

YES! In order to have the best experience possible, all groups participating in this event will need to have a reservation. Groups that do not have a reservation will not have access to the buffet, soda wristbands, camping area, badges, or special presentations. September 16th is the last day to register for this event. Payment must be made for entire group with one transaction. A group consists of a minimum of 15 attendees. If you do not meet this qualification, please consider partnering up with another troop in your area.

What are the park hours for this event?

Tell me more about the BONUS I see offered on the registration form.

For this event, groups that are registered by Friday, September 5th, and paid for by Friday, September 12, will receive one complimentary package for each 15 paid attendees. The complimentary package includes everything that the *Scouting Days Package* offers. This package can be used for a leader or to scholarship a deserving scout in your troop. You do not receive credit toward the bonus for *Passholder Packages*.

Tell me more about the 2-day ticket that is provided with this package.

Each attendee will receive a ticket that must be used on the next consecutive operating day and is non-transferable. Since we are on a limited operating calendar, this ticket is only valid on Saturday, September 20th and Sunday, September 21st.

When can we pick up our tickets?

Tickets will be available upon arrival at the park. A registration/welcome table will be set up just inside the courtyard. If there are no changes to your reservation, you will receive your admission tickets and soda wristbands, and will be able to proceed directly to the gate.

Changes will be accepted on the day of the event, but will need to be processed through Group Sales. Please understand that there may be a significant wait in order to process changes. If you know of changes prior to your arrival, please let us know so that we can expedite your group's admission.

What special shows will be offered for the scouts?

On both Saturday and Sunday, we will offer special shows and events for scouts only. Scouts will be able to experience Wild Adventures like never before. We are waiting to finalize specifics until we know the age groups we are expecting. A final e-mail will be sent to all of the group leaders the week of the event.

How is the buffet going to work?

The buffet will be provided on Saturday afternoon and will be located in our concert area. Each group will be assigned a specific one hour time block to eat. Assignments will be made based on when we receive your completed registration forms. The buffet will consist of all you can eat chicken tenders, hot dogs, potato chips, ice cream cups and Coca-Cola beverages.

Can you provide more details on the options available for camping?

The camping area will be available from 5:00 p.m. on Friday until 11:00 a.m. on Sunday. Camping is provided at no charge and portable restrooms will be available. There is no additional charge for camping. A large campfire will be provided by Wild Adventures staff on Saturday night.

I heard that we will be able to fish.

Our Animal Care team will be leading campers on an optional fishing excursion Saturday night. It will take place inside the park and will be Catch-and-Release. Campers wishing to fish will need to bring fishing poles. Bait will be provided. Chaperones must accompany their scouts for this outing.

Will there be showers available?

There will not be showers available at the camping site; however, you may use the showers at Splash Island during normal operating hours.

Can we have our own campfire?

You will be permitted to cook at your campsite on certified equipment only such as Coleman stoves or charcoal grills. However, open campfires or fires in barrels will not be permitted. You may bring your own food and beverages into the camping area, but may not be brought inside the gates of the park. Wild Adventures will be setting up a large campfire on Saturday night.

Is there a place to stay if we don't want to camp?

There are a number of hotels in close proximity to Wild Adventures. We will be happy to put you in touch with one of our partner hotels (which are also listed on our website.)
